We are committed to promoting the right to health for all, with a focus on young people, women, and vulnerable populations. Additionally, we address the intersection of PRNDs and SRHR, particularly by promoting women's health, tackling issues such as the lack of sex- and gender-disaggregated data, underrepresentation of women in clinical trials, and the funding gap for health issues that disproportionately affect women.

Our expertise is recognised through effective engagement with EU and other public authorities, international organisations, and a broad range of stakeholders. We excel in facilitating debates, analysing policy and funding developments, and identifying opportunities for collaboration in global health. These activities align closely with BCH's goals of enhancing Belgium's contribution to global health policies and promoting health as a fundamental right.

As an organisation that values collaboration and mutual learning, DSW would greatly benefit from closer engagement with BCH and its members. Similarly, we believe we would contribute to BCH's mission and vision, particularly via the working groups on access to medicines and SRHR.
