Practical:

- the SRHR WG meets 5-6 times a year;
- the membership list consists of about 55 people and we have about 20-25 active members who attend regularly,

Content-wise:

- we did 3 major conferences this year where we were part of either the organization, the panel, the workshop, the moderation...
 - ARGO-conference
 - ANSER-conference
 - BE EU-conference: the minister of development cooperation participated in our workshop on SRHR
- as there is a lot of knowledge and experience on decolonization of SRHR within the WG SRHR, we are always on a path towards decolonizing SRHR and trying to create tools on decolonizing SRHR.
- we try to connect with our network on SRHR and have them present different topics related to SRHR
 - UNFPA presented their SWOP-report
 - Ipas presented their report on Project 2025
 - DGD presented their plans on UHC and HSS
- we concern ourselves with the promotion, update and expansion of the e-tutorial of Body&Rights
 - B&R is updated yearly with the right numbers and new sources in the factsheets
 - B&R will be renewed, the WG SRHR will assemble a taskforce B&R to renew and update B&R and to host the website.
 - WG SRHR will recruit people to provide input on the contents of B&R and the (new) themes that will be incorporated (young people, people with expertise on climate change and SRHR...)
